



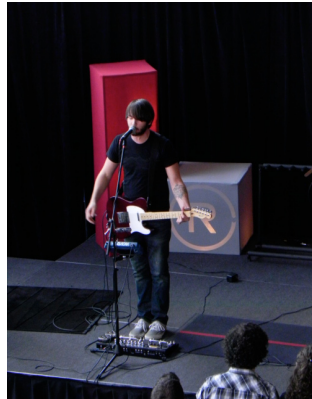

A lot of exciting things have been happening in r-World. New classroom names, r-Garden (nursery), r-Backyard (preschool), and r-City (elementary), as well as a new mascot (Rad) have brought much excitement to the ministry. At the launch service, we saw a 10-year-old girl give her life to Christ!



We are pumped about what God has planned for r-World. This month, our nursery and preschool children will be celebrating that Jesus cares for them and that He wants to help them, both with the big things and the little things. Jesus did some pretty amazing things while He was on the earth with us. We are going to introduce our preschoolers to those miracles this month.



Our young friends will review their five senses as they learn how Jesus healed a blind man and a man who couldn't hear or speak. They will learn that Jesus loved and cared for everyone, even the lepers who were shunned by their peers. They also will experience the story of amazing friendship as we tell the story of the four men who carried their friend to Jesus and lowered him through the roof to be healed. Through each of these stories, our preschoolers will learn that "Jesus cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7, CEV).



Our elementary students will be learning about courage, which is being brave enough to do what you should do even when you are afraid. The theme for the month is "Fear Factor," as in not letting fear factor into our decisions about how to live.
