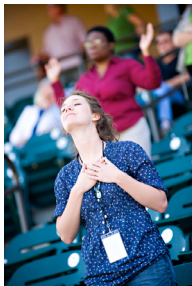

We have a building! After much prayer and searching, the Lord has provided a place for us to meet. Our Preview and Launch Services will be held in the Milton Rhodes Center for the Arts in Downtown Winston-Salem. This building is owned by the Winston-Salem Arts Council, is newly renovated and opened just a few months ago. There is a large auditorium with space for 325 chairs and a room that can be used for overflow with space for an additional 200 seats. In a display of His providence, when Russ met with the Events Coordinator we found out that she and her husband have been following us on Twitter for the past 6 months. God was developing a relationship before we even knew this building existed! We are incredibly excited about this facility and are working to establish a long-term lease with the Arts Council. Please pray that this space will be an open door into the community and that an affordable leasing option can be negotiated.
