We were then able to help pack over 200 backpacks with a variety of basic school supplies and a note letting the recipients know that we are praying for them as they start school. Some of the backpacks were delivered to the homes of children whose parents had requested assistance. Others were passed out at a YMCA-hosted event for homeless children in Forsyth county. Through these activities, REVO was able to serve these children in a tangible way, give them the necessary tools to succeed this school year, and build and develop relationships with other ministries in the area.
